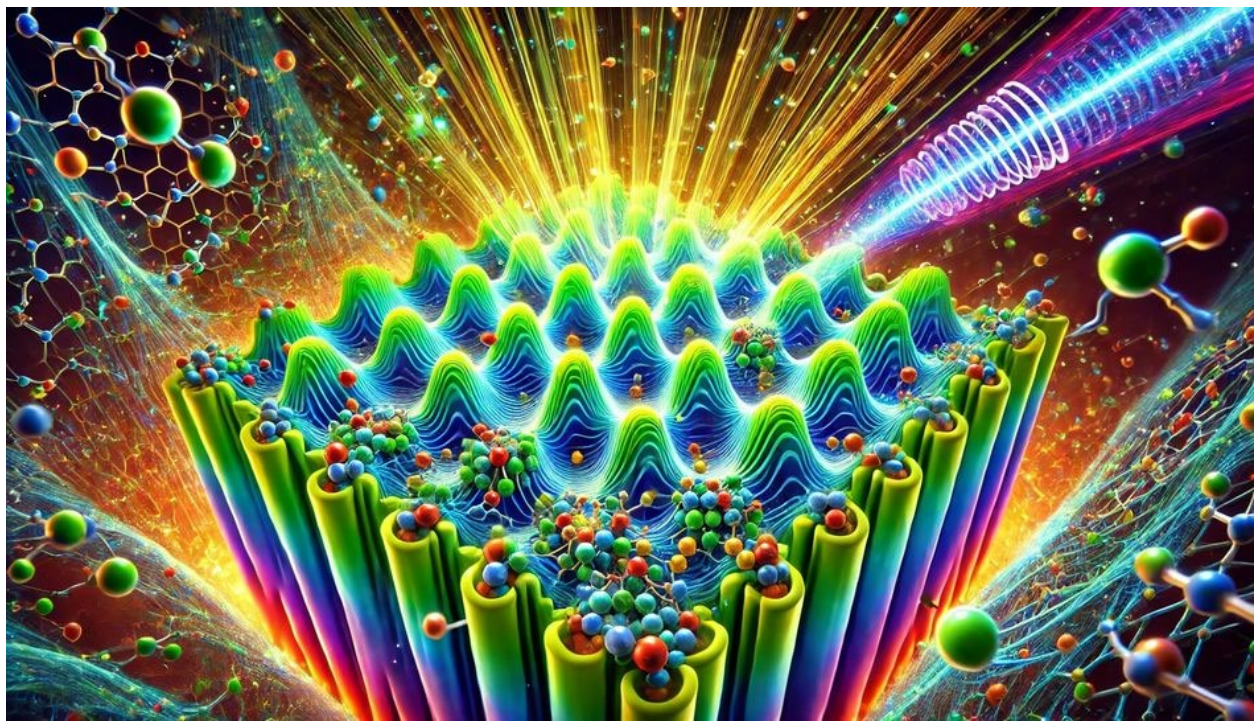

Has the plan been all along for President Biden to drop out of the US elections? The rumour mill is suggesting that he could drop out as early as this Monday. And not just drop out of the elections but retire as President and hand over the reins to Kamala Harris before a new candidate is found to challenge and beat Trump. A new candidate that will pull all shy Trump voters over to the Democrats and ensure Trump loses convincingly.

Already, the seeds are being sown with papers reporting on a Reuters/Ipsos poll which showed 50% of voters would vote for Michelle Obama if she was running. Only 39% would vote for Trump against Obama. The nudging is in full force.

It makes perfect sense as a Democrat plan - Biden is being thrown under the bus and Harris is nowhere near popular enough to win. After October: new levels of repression

While all pales in comparison to Israel's genocidal campaign in Gaza, the Israeli crackdown on resistance in the West Bank took on an entirely different meaning after October 7. Israel revoked tens of thousands of work permits for Palestinians, blocked dozens of roads that Palestinians used to move around between cities and villages in the West Bank, and dramatically intensified its arrest campaign against Palestinians.

In the first two months after October 7, Israel doubled the already existing Palestinian prison population, at one point reaching over 10,000 prisoners. The number of administrative detainees — those detained without charge or trial — has reached 3,600, whereas the number was 1,300 before the war.

The scope of arrests also increased, widening to include Palestinians from all walks of life, including many who are not politically active. Many of the arrestees are community leaders, journalists, and civil society activists with little to no tenuous ties to politics. Inside the prisons, human rights reports and testimonies of released Palestinians all revealed unprecedented levels of humiliation, abuse, and torture, effectively extending the genocide of Palestinians to Palestinian prisoners in Israeli custody.

According to a spokesperson of the Addameer Prisoner Support Association, who asked not to be quoted by name, "Israeli arrests systematically target active members of the community who have the capacity of mobilizing it, especially those who have a past in doing so," adding that "this is clearly seen in the arrests of individuals who work in civil society, in academia, in the media, and in human rights."

MOSCOW (Sputnik) - The Russian Federal Security Service (FSB) said on Monday that it had prevented an attempt by the Ukrainian special services to hijack a Russian Tu-22M3 strike bomber with the help of NATO allies.

"The Russian FSB has prevented another attempt of the Ukrainian special services to hijack a long-range strategic bomber Tu-22M3 of the Russian aerospace forces and fly it abroad. The involvement of special services of NATO member states in the preparation and implementation of the operation has been uncovered," the agency said in a statement.

Tupolev's **Tu-22M3** long-range supersonic **missile carrier bomber** (NATO reporting name: Backfire) is designed to destroy sea- and ground-based targets by means of guided missiles and aerial bombs.

Gaza death toll could be five times higher – study

When disease and hunger are taken into account, researchers have argued that the conflict could claim nearly 200,000 Palestinian lives

The true death toll in Gaza could exceed 186,000, five times higher than the 37,396 reported last month by the enclave's health authorities, according to a new study published in *The Lancet* medical journal.

As of June 19, Israel's war on Hamas had killed 37,396 people in Gaza, according to the Gaza Health Ministry. While the Israeli government has long disputed the ministry's figures, they are accepted as reliable by the UN, and quietly [acknowledged](#) to be true by the Israeli military.

According to a team of British, American, and Canadian researchers, this figure could swell to 186,000 when "indirect deaths" are counted. "Indirect deaths," they wrote in an [article](#) published last week, include those killed

by disease, hunger, thirst, and exposure.

"In recent conflicts, such indirect deaths range from three to 15 times the number of direct deaths," the article read. "Applying a conservative estimate of four indirect deaths per one direct death to the 37,396 deaths reported, it is not implausible to estimate that up to 186,000 or even more deaths could be attributable to the current conflict in Gaza."

With the population of Gaza around 2.3 million before the conflict began, such a death toll translates to the enclave losing between 7% and 9% of its population.

"An immediate and urgent ceasefire in the Gaza Strip is essential, accompanied by measures to enable the distribution of medical supplies, food, clean water, and other resources for basic human needs," the authors argued, adding that Israel is required by the International Court of Justice to document and preserve evidence that could implicate it in genocide.

After nine months of fighting, Israel has come under intense international pressure to halt its military campaign in Gaza. While Hamas has accepted a US-sponsored ceasefire proposal, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu stated on Sunday that any potential deal must allow Israel to resume fighting

until all of its war objectives – which include the destruction of Hamas' military capabilities – are met.

While Hamas and Israel both agree that a deal would allow the phased exchange of Israeli hostages in Gaza for Palestinian prisoners in Israeli jails, the Palestinian militant group wants written guarantees from international mediators that Israel will continue to negotiate a permanent ceasefire when the first phase of the agreement comes into effect.

Talks mediated by Qatar, Egypt and the US have so far failed to secure a truce in Gaza or the release of hostages since a weeklong ceasefire in November resulting in the freeing of 105 hostages from Gaza and 240 Palestinian prisoners.

US President Joe Biden's every movement is planned by his assistants, with photos showing the elderly leader exactly how to get to the podium at events, Axios reported on Monday. Biden has come under pressure to quit his reelection campaign after a debate with Donald Trump exposed his apparently declining cognitive ability.

Before each of his public appearances, Biden's staffers prepare a document for the president, detailing how he will enter the venue, how he will walk to the podium, and how he will face the audience, the US news site reported. Images of these documents show full-page photographs of the route Biden will walk, with simple, one-line text instructions such as "Walk to the podium."

"I staffed a simple fundraiser at a private residence, but they treated it like it was a NATO summit with his movements," one person who arranged staffing for a Biden event this year told Axios.

"It surprised me that a seasoned political pro like the president would need detailed verbal and visual instructions on how to enter and exit a room," the staffer added.

The purpose of such provocations is to secure further financing for the Kiev regime and continue the war to the last Ukrainian, the ministry emphasized.

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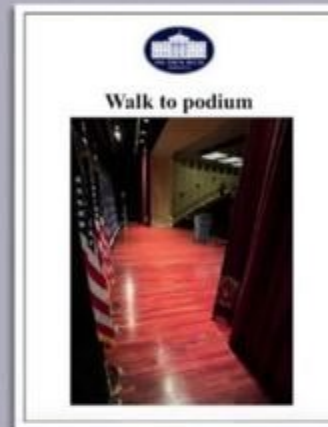
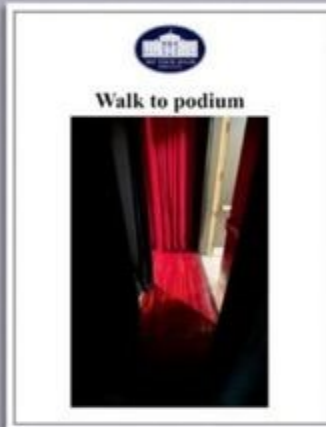

Xi Jinping meets Hungarian PM

The Chinese leader has welcomed Viktor Orban to Beijing

Chinese President Xi Jinping held a meeting with Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban, who is currently in Beijing on what he previously dubbed a peacekeeping mission, Xinhua reported on Monday morning.

The details of the meeting and the exact topics of discussion have yet to be revealed, but it comes in the wake of Orban's trips to Kiev and Moscow last week. The Hungarian PM called the Beijing trip a *"peace mission 3.0"* in a brief post upon his arrival.

Orban embarked on his *"peacekeeping mission"* last week with an unannounced trip to Kiev, where he proposed a *"quick ceasefire"* to

Ukraine's President Vladimir Zelensky. The Hungarian PM then traveled to Moscow to discuss the *"shortest way out"* of the conflict with Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Moscow and Kiev's positions remain very *"far apart,"* according to Orban, who noted that Zelensky *"didn't like"* his proposals much. Meanwhile, Putin reiterated Moscow's readiness to resolve hostilities through negotiations but noted that the Ukrainian leadership appears committed to waging war *"until the end."*

Orban's meeting with Putin angered some fellow EU leaders, while Kiev expressed fury that the Hungarian leader went to Russia *"without approval or coordination with Ukraine."*

A nation in pain: How political idealism destroyed Ukraine

The conflict is about NATO and its expansion, and Moscow sees Kiev as a proxy for the bloc

Political realism is commonly and mistakenly portrayed as immoral because its principal focus is on an inescapable security competition, and it thus rejects idealist efforts to transcend power politics. Because states cannot break away from security competition, morality for the realist entails acting in accordance with the balance of power logic as the foundation for stability and peace. Idealist efforts to break with power politics can then be defined as immoral, as they undermine the management of the security competition as the foundation of peace. As Raymond Aron expressed in 1966: *"The idealist, believing he has broken with power politics exaggerates its crimes."*

Ukraine's sovereign right to join

NATO

The most appealing and dangerous idealist argument that destroyed Ukraine is that it has the right to join any military alliance it desires. It is a very attractive statement that can easily win support from the public, as it affirms the freedom and sovereignty of Ukraine, and the alternative is seemingly that Russia should be allowed to dictate Ukraine's policies.

However, arguing that Ukraine should be allowed to join any military alliance is an idealist argument, as it appeals to how we would like the world to be, not how the world actually works. The principle that peace is derived from the expansion of military alliances without taking into account the security interests of other great powers has never existed. States such as Ukraine that border a great power have every reason to express legitimate security concerns, but inviting a rival great power such as the US into its territory intensifies the security competition.

Is it moral to insist on how the world ought to be when war is the consequence of ignoring how the world actually works?

The alternative to expanding NATO is not to accept a Russian *sphere of influence*, which denotes a zone of exclusive influence. Peace is derived from recognizing a Russian *sphere of interests*, which is an area where Russian security interests must be recognized and incorporated rather than excluded. It did not use to be controversial to argue that Russian security interests must be taken into account when operating on its borders. This is why Europe had a belt of neutral states as a buffer between East and West during the Cold War to mitigate the security competition.

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As of 2024 the United States is still the only country to have deployed nuclear weapons in a military setting, killing over 150,000 people in nuclear attacks in Japan as the country was on the brink of surrender amid an looming Russian attack.

Prominent figures in the United States national security establishment are pushing a resumption of nuclear weapons testing as the country continues to move towards weakening international arms control frameworks.

Former US national security advisor Robert O'Brien and George W. Bush State Department adviser Christian Whiton are among the foreign policy luminaries pushing the policy.

The Heritage Foundation think tank is also urging immediate nuclear testing if former President Donald Trump wins the White House this fall; the organization urged a remediation of "former Manhattan Project and Cold War nuclear material sites" in a recent policy blueprint, demonstrating the continued influence of neoconservative foreign policy advocacy in Republican Party politics.

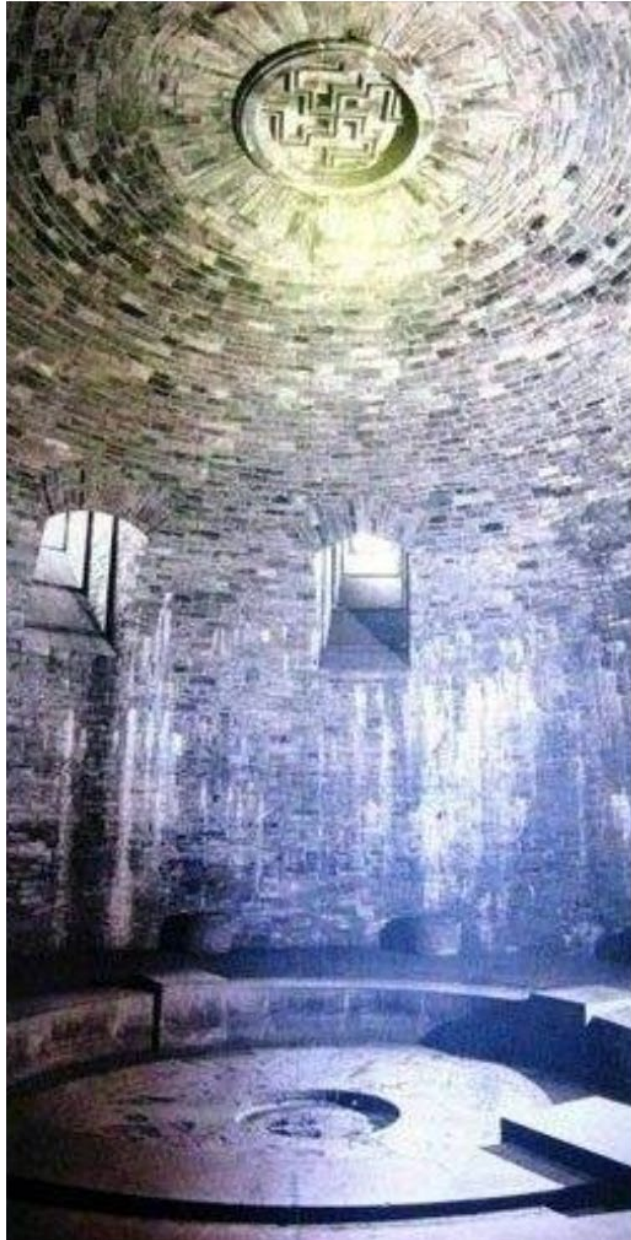

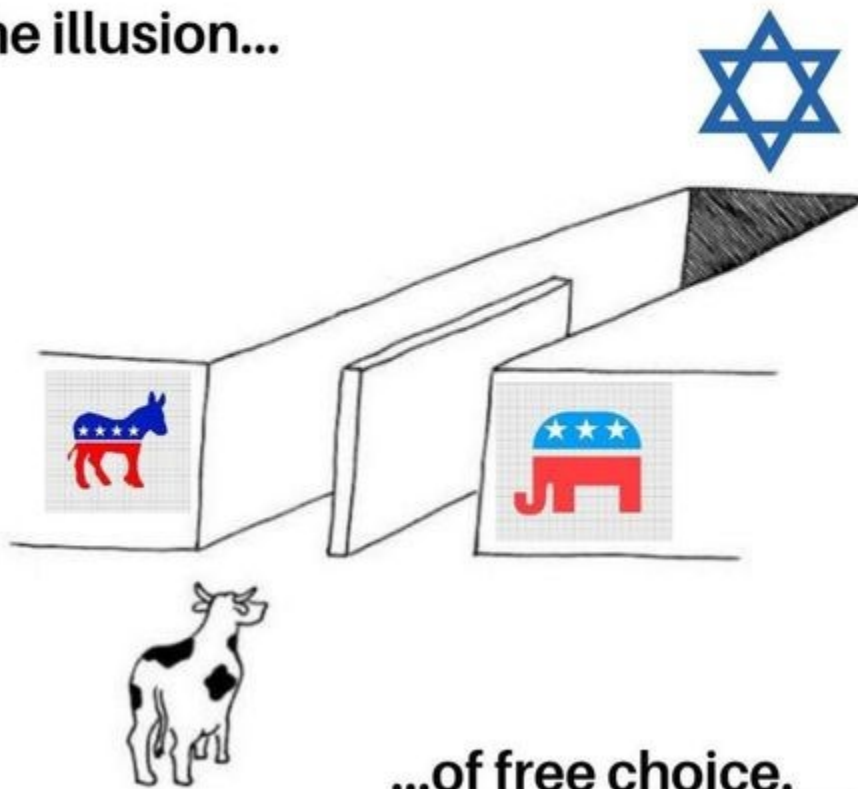

MOSCOW/NEW DELHI, July 8. /TASS/. Russian President Vladimir Putin will meet with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who is about to arrive in Russia with an official visit. The Prime Minister's trip is expected to last for two days - on July 8 and 9. New Delhi expects the prime minister to arrive in Moscow in the second half of Monday.

The Kremlin's announcement of the visit mentions the nature of the "traditionally friendly Russian-Indian relations," further development of which the two leaders plan to discuss. Other topics of the conversation include "current issues of international and regional agenda."

Kremlin Spokesman Dmitry Peskov spoke about the anticipation of this "important, full-format visit," adding that the two leaders will also be able to talk in an informal environment. Presidential Aide Yury Ushakov also noted that the Kremlin "assigns the top priority to this visit."

Last time, Modi visited Russia in 2019, when he came to Vladivostok; 2015 was the last time he visited Moscow.

Orban makes surprise visit to China

The Hungarian PM has landed in Beijing following his visits to Kiev and Moscow last week

Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban has arrived in China as part of his "peace mission" tour, which included meetings with Russian President Vladimir Putin in Moscow and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky in Kiev.

The Hungarian leader confirmed he is already in China with a photo of China's Deputy Foreign Minister Hua Chunying greeting him at the airport and a brief post on X (formerly Twitter) on Monday morning, saying: "Peace mission 3.0 Beijing."

The news of a possible visit to Beijing was first reported by the Hungarian news portal 444, which wrote on Sunday that Orban was "scheduled to arrive in the Asian country at

dawn on Monday."

Last week, Orban traveled to Kiev, where he met with Zelensky in an effort to persuade him to consider ceasefire talks with Moscow. The Hungarian PM then embarked on a surprise visit to Moscow, which, according to his office, was part of Orban's "peacekeeping mission."

Orban and Putin engaged in several hours of discussion aimed at finding the "shortest way out" of the conflict in Ukraine. The Hungarian leader, however, admitted that Moscow and Kiev remain "very far apart," noting that Zelensky "didn't like" his proposals much.

Orban's surprise trip to Russia sparked fury in Kiev and among fellow EU leaders, but the Hungarian PM stated that one of the most important steps to ending the conflict is "establishing contact" and argued that he doesn't require an EU mandate to promote peace. Hungary, which currently holds the rotating EU presidency, is one of the few bloc members, alongside neighboring Slovakia, that maintains neutrality and refuses to send weapons to Ukraine.

The visit to Beijing comes as Hungary canceled "at short notice" a meeting between Foreign Minister Peter Szijarto and his German counterpart, Annalena Baerbock.



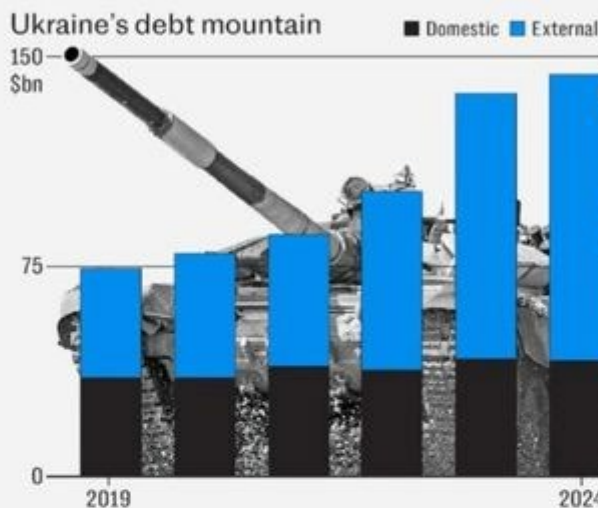

Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orbán has arrived in Beijing where he will hold talks with Chinese President Xi Jinping, Orbán's spokesman Bertalan Havashi said.

He called the visit the next stage of a peace mission, with the previous stage being his trip to Kiev on July 2. Orbán said he intended to hold several "equally unexpected" meetings next week.

Nearly 70% of Israelis believe regime far from winning Gaza war: Poll

More than two-thirds of Israelis have no hope for the occupying regime winning its genocidal war on the Gaza Strip, a new survey reveals.

According to the poll published by Israel's Channel 12 News on Friday, 68 percent of Israelis believe that the usurping entity is far from the "total victory" pledged by Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in the Gaza offensive, compared to 23 percent who said Israel is close and 9 percent who were unsure.

Asked about Netanyahu's handling of the aggression against the besieged Palestinian territory, 68 percent of respondents gave the Israeli premier a bad grade, while only 28 percent gave him a good grade and 4 percent were not sure.

Israel unleashed its brutal Gaza offensive on October 7 after the Palestinian Hamas resistance group carried out a surprise operation in retaliation for the regime's intensified atrocities against the Palestinian people.

However, over nine months into the war, the Tel Aviv regime has failed to achieve its objectives of eliminating Hamas and finding Israeli captives in Gaza despite killing at least 87,705 Palestinians, mostly women and children, and injuring 85,523 others.

Asked why the Gaza assault has not ended yet, 54 percent of participants in the survey said it is because of Netanyahu's political considerations, 34 percent said it is due to substantive and operational reasons and 12 were not sure.

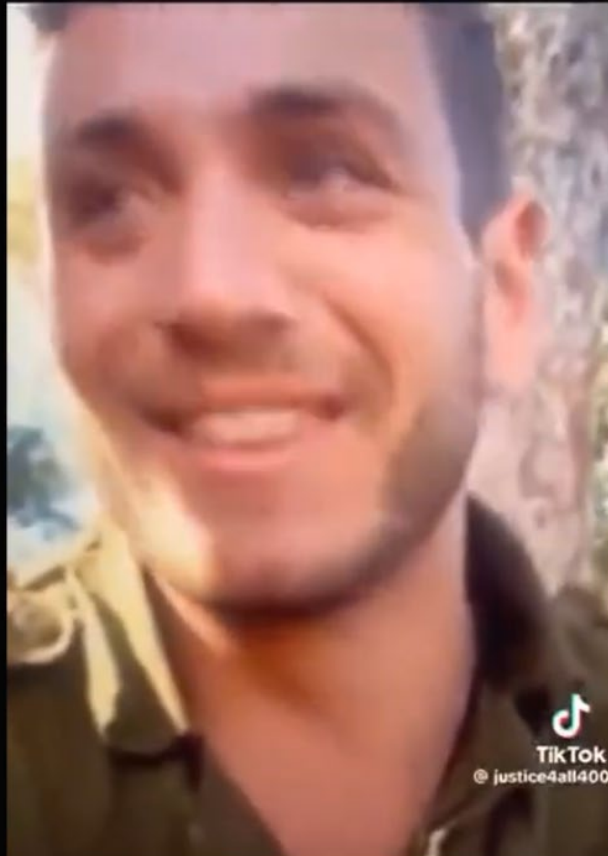

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The US House Oversight Committee "is concerned" that medical assessments of **Biden's health** by the president's physician "have been influenced by... private business endeavors with the Biden family," according to a press release from the committee.

The body has requested a transcribed interview with President Biden's physician, read the statement published on its website.

"House Committee on Oversight and Accountability Chairman James Comer (R-Ky.) today is calling on President Biden's physician, Dr. Kevin O'Connor, to appear for a transcribed interview regarding his medical assessments of President Biden and his private endeavors with the Biden family's business schemes," the release said.

"Recent evidence obtained by the Committee shows Dr. O'Connor's and James Biden's involvement with Americore Health, LLC, a company that operated rural hospitals and is currently involved in bankruptcy proceedings. James Biden, the President's brother, used funds from Americore to pay Joe Biden \$200,000 as the company was facing financial distress. James Biden received payments for \$400,000 and \$200,000, characterized as loans, from the company that were wired directly to his bank account," the release said.

"During his transcribed interview, James Biden confirmed Dr. O'Connor provided him counsel in connection with the alleged work he was performing for Americore," the statement read.

"To understand the extent of your involvement in the Biden family's financial activity, we request that you produce all documents and communications in your possession regarding Americore and James Biden," the group declared.
